Minutes for August 23rd Council Meeting

The Grand Knight called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. He led the Council in an Opening Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

The recorder called the roll. All officers were present except: DGK, Inside Guard and Trustee Martin.

Reading of July minutes waived but approved as published in the August issue of "Calling All Knights".

Grand Knight welcomed new members to their first meeting.

Lecturer Francisco Cabrita introduced guest speaker and fellow 4060 Council member Brandon Macadaeg.

Our guest speaker's topic was, "How to make the most of Mass". He noted when we come to mass we should take a "Theological Stance" ie when we come to mass we should see Gods beloved son and we should talk to him. Practical ways to get the most out of mass include:

- 1.) Arrive a little early and say a few prayers: he suggested it might include an "Act of Contrition".
- 2.) Read some scripture. He noted mass prayers are full of scripture.
- 3.) Listen attentively.
- 4.) Mass can be a mission – after attending "go out and do".
- 5.) Mass in itself is a prayer.

Grand Knight welcomed our Chapter President T. W. Starkweather – He talked about "Unity" and noted that when we ban together, through unity we can even overcome tragedy.

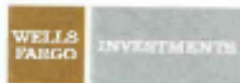
